Course Description

This qualification applies to individuals working as a pre-press tradesperson. Typically they design and prepare layouts and artwork, manipulate images and text to meet production and design requirements and apply solutions to a defined range of problems associated with, and characteristic to, the print medium. They may also provide some leadership and guidance to others with some limited responsibility for the output of others.

Students successfully completing the course will receive the Nationally Recognised; ICP31415 Certificate III in Print Communications.
