

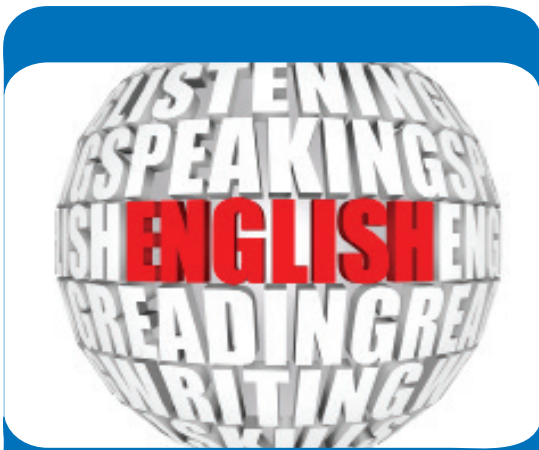

### General English

## Course Description

ANC's General English courses teach students how to use English in a variety of everyday situations and practical settings. This course covers the four macro skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing. It also helps student to gain necessary knowledge in order to continue further study.

## Course Outcome

### Elementary Level

*At the end of the this level students would have been able to:*

- Listen to a range of simple conversations and demonstrate understanding
- Able to take part in group conversations and present a topic using basic English, speaking in full sentences

### Pre-Intermediate Level

*At the end of the this level students would have been able to:*

- Listen for information in a talk (statistics dates, etc)
- Write a short story or summary, using full sentences and paragraphs
- Use correct pronunciation

### Intermediate Level

*At the end of the this level students would have been able to:*

- Understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics.
- Produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue, giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

### Advanced Level

*At the end of the this level students would have been able to:*

- Demonstrate the collaborative, social aspects of writing, including the ability to use writing as a tool for learning.
- Identify, select, and analyse appropriate research methods, questions, and evidence for a specific rhetorical situation.

## Course Duration

This course is offered full time over **52 Weeks including holidays** on a full time basis.

Students may choose to exit the course at the end of **elementary, pre-intermediate, intermediate or advanced** level.

## Contact Hours

20 hours per week face to face/classroom for 40 Weeks.

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## Entry Requirements

### Age Requirements

ANC has a requirement that all students must be over 18 years of age at the commencement of course.

### English Language Requirements

English Placement Test to determine English Level is carried out at the beginning of the course. The test takes up to 2 hours to complete and is at no cost to students.

## Teaching Methods

ANC utilises a blended delivery mode which incorporates face to face delivery in classrooms, roleplays, individual tasks and team based tasks.

## Assessments

Assessment is by coursework, which integrates the following:

- Individual and group oral presentations
- Oral interactions (including pair work)
- Written Vocabulary and Grammar tests and tasks
- Essays
- Listening/ viewing
- Communicating the gist of simple reading passages
- Translation of simple texts
